

Dear colleagues, last year, the government of Hainan province has expanded the list of countries whose citizens may visit Hainan Island on a visa-free list, and now citizens of 59 countries can fly on a visa-free list.

List of countries included in the visa-free policy

The countries are as follows: Russia, the United Kingdom, France, Germany, Norway, Ukraine, Italy, Austria, Finland, Netherlands, Denmark, Switzerland, Sweden, Spain, Belgium, Czech Republic, Estonia, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Poland, Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia, Ireland, Cyprus, Bulgaria, Romania, Serbia, Croatia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Montenegro, Macedonia, Albania, the United States, Canada, Brazil, Mexico, Argentina, Chile, Australia, New Zealand, South Korea, Japan, Singapore, Malaysia, Thailand, Kazakhstan, Philippines, Indonesia, Brunei, UAE, Qatar, Monaco, and Belarus.

Adding a tourist to the visa-free list is possible if:

- **if there is a full package of documents: a round-trip ticket, accommodation, medical insurance policy, transfer;**
- **Passport must be valid for at least 6 months from the moment of arrival from China.**

According to the law:

- a tourist who is included in the group visa-free list does not have the right to leave the island, even with a valid consular visa, be serviced by the other receiving party, independently change the hotel and location in China without warning;
- change the duration of the tour while on the island;
- when crossing the border, a tourist does not have the right to independently decide to open a visa upon arrival or to leave the group visa-free list;
- violation of the visa regime by tourists can lead to problems when leaving the country, as well as a fine by the Chinese border services, deportation, etc.

Terms and conditions:

- Lists are formed from minimum one person
- Citizens from all 59 countries with the same stay and the same flight numbers can be on the same list!
- Duration of stay on Hainan Island is up to 30 days

Tourists who arrived on the island on a visa-free list have the right to be only in the territory of Hainan Island, departure to mainland China is strictly prohibited!

During a visa-free stay on Hainan Island, foreigners must abide by the laws of the PRC. It is strictly forbidden to exceed the permitted period of stay on Hainan Island and travel to Mainland China.

For visa-free lists, passport scans are required.

Scan of passport must be sent strictly in the next format:

It is necessary to download a color scanned copy of the full spread of the passport, oriented vertically, cropped clearly along the contour, in JPG format, in good quality.

More details:

- The scan of the passport should be clear, in color, in a full spread, oriented vertically (sample in the attachment)
- The scan of the passport must be cut clearly along the contour. (wrong scan is in attachments).
- Passport scan should be downloaded only in JPG format
- The passport scan **MUST NOT** be flipped or turned to the side. The page with the photo and information about the person should be at the **BOTTOM**. (wrong scan is in attachments).
- The passport photographed on the phone is not accepted!
- The passport in black and white is not accepted!
- The permissible size of the scanned document should not exceed 100Kb (KB)
- The name of the scanned passport must match the passport number (Sample in the attachment). Meaning, the name of the passport is its number.

ATTENTION! For the correctness of entering the passport data of tourists in the visa free list, the agency bears financial responsibility. If in the process of crossing the border in China, inaccuracies are found in the tourist data provided by the agency when booking, the visa-free list for this tourist will be invalid. In this case, the tourist will be forced to buy a visa upon arrival at the airport of Sanya, costing \$ 75.

A group visa-free list will be formed from the data entered into the visa free list by the agency itself. Please carefully fill in the tourist data in the list, because if there are mistakes, the tourist may not be allowed to fly and may be deported from China.

The border checkpoint of China has the right to restrict the actions of the person crossing the border, as well as to check if there is a suspicion of a threat to national security, state interests and public order.
